- Haidene Maltz is going to Melbourne for Easter to catch up with the 3 grandchildren there. She gets to see the 2 in Sydney quite regularly.

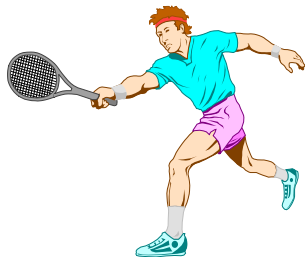
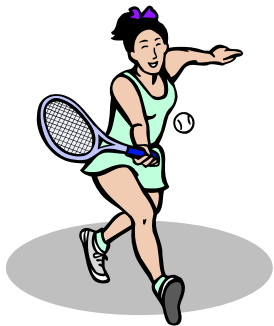
- Tania Duffy won Gold in the Women's Singles at this year's NSW Corporate Games, held in March at Cintra Tennis Centre, Concord.
