



## AVAILABILITY OF TENNIS COURTS TO MEMBERS

Please note that there are strict rules for the use of courts by members outside of regular club occasions. The courts are managed Monday to Friday (up to 7.30pm) and Saturday mornings by our coach David Falconer and it is important that the club respect his business and clients during these times.

The following rules must be adhered to if members wish to use the courts.

### 325A Eastern Valley Way, Chatswood

- All members must report to the pro shop (phone 9417 7888)
  - Monday- Friday, before 7:30pm
  - Saturday, before 12:30pmor the bar (phone 9417 3072)
  - Monday- Friday, after 7:30pm
  - Saturday, after 12:30pm
  - Sunday

... to inquire if there is a court available for them and if so, which one. If you do not do this you will be asked to vacate the courts and membership privileges will not be available.

- Members must produce their membership card to the pro shop or bar staff member to validate their membership status. All players wanting to play must produce their current membership cards to receive the maximum benefit of free use or the 25 % discount.
- Members playing with any player who is not a member (or with a member who has not produced a current membership card), will pay the reduced court hire fee (25% discount).
- Members wanting to be guaranteed a court may book and pay the reduced court hire fee (i.e. 25% discount) however you must mention that you are a member when making the booking. Subsequent cancelling of this booking and then arriving casually to play will result in loss of court hire entitlements for this member with not even discounts applying for the remainder of the membership year.
- Staff from the pro shop or bar staff have the right to ask any member who has not followed the above procedures to vacate the courts.
- If a customer of the coach or an evening casual booking requires the court, members will have to vacate the court (unless they have booked).
- Any member not notifying the pro shop or the bar of their attendance will have their card terminated.
- This privilege is for casual use only. Any member using the courts on a regular basis will be required to pay normal court hire rates.
- Members wanting to use the courts with other members during the weekend must seek permission from the Club Captain, Colin Ritchie, before playing. You will then either be asked to join the club social tennis group or if courts are available, Colin will allocate you a court. If you bring a non-club member you will need to hire the court with discounts as above. (See bar staff in this instance.)

### TYNESIDE AVENUE

- Rules as above plus: Members should call the pro shop for weekday use or the bar for weekend use, to inquire if there are any courts available and what number court they may use. However members will have to move if a client hires the court after the member's inquiry, or book and pay for the court yourself to guarantee it as per above conditions.
- Must produce membership cards on request.

### MEMBERSHIP CARDS

Membership Cards will be issued on the following dates:

7 March	for those members financial up to 19 February
31 March	for those members financial up to 12 March
15 July	for those members financial up to 30 June

Other late payments will be processed on an *ad hoc* basis. You cannot use the courts mid-week without a membership card. If you are late with your fees then the privilege of using the courts mid-week will not be available until the next round of cards are issued. If you have paid within timeframes and have not received your membership card, then you must still pay the court hire fee as requested, then subsequently notify Kit Meyers by phone on 9484 5148, who will arrange for a refund as appropriate. This measure will prevent non-financial members claiming that they are current members.
